TO: PUBLIC CHARITIES PROVIDING SERVICES AND/OR CARE TO FAMILIES COPING WITH LIFE-THREATENING ILLNESS OR BEREAVEMENT

The **RISA S. ROSENGARD FOUNDATION, INC.** is a not-for-profit, volunteer-driven organization dedicated to helping children and families cope with the devastating effects from a life-threatening illness or bereavement after the loss of a loved one. The **mission** of the Foundation is to provide grants to 501(c)(3) organizations for programs that support families going through or recovering from a life-threatening illness or grieving the loss of a loved one. The **vision** of the Foundation is that no child or family member should go through these dark times feeling alone or helpless. Through our support, families have access to the critical services they need during this difficult time.

If you are providing, or plan to provide, these services, you are invited to submit a grant to The Risa S. Rosengard Foundation, Inc. Requests will be evaluated in a timely fashion by the Board of Directors. Only one request per year will be considered from an organization. Budgets should be limited to \$5,000 or less for this first year of operation of the Foundation.

Please provide the following information in six pages or less, including the application cover page:

1. A copy of the organization's most recent IRS tax-exempt determination letter
2. Brief history of the organization including date of establishment
3. Mission Statement of the organization
4. Unique aspects of your program and its relationship to other similar programs
5. Purpose and amount of the grant requested and project budget
6. Anticipated results of the project
7. Other funding sources currently available for the project
8. List of officers, directors, number of paid staff and volunteers of the organization
9. Number of patients and/or family members served each year

The Risa S. Rosengard Foundation, Inc. will fund only public charities and cannot consider requests for (i) individuals; (ii) organizations that do not have 501(c)(3) status;

(iii) endowment funds; or (iv) religious affiliated projects. Grants will not be made to support an organization's annual operating expenses or to be used for the construction or renovation of an organization's facilities. Each grant recipient is required to furnish the Risa S. Rosengard Foundation, Inc. with a follow-up report detailing how the grant funds were utilized and the results. Failure to submit this information will preclude consideration for future funding to your organization. We further request that any funding granted to your organization be publicly acknowledged.
